

BuildSim Nordic Conference - keynote speakers

Background

The BuildSim Nordic conference is hosted by Technical University of Denmark (DTU) on August 22nd-23rd 2022. The conference unites researchers, practitioners, educators and students to exchange ideas, issues and research findings in the field of building performance simulation.

BuildSim Nordic 2022 is the 10th BuildSim Nordic conference and the 2nd International Nordic conference for IBPSA, the International Building Performance Simulation Association.

Any research related to building simulation, including system design, building services and installations, heat pumps, energy production/use/storage, indoor climate and environmental issues, is eligible to be presented at the event.

The event is open for members and non-members of IBPSA-Nordic as well as practitioners from the architectural, engineering and construction industry.

Keynote speakers

The conference has announced two international keynote speakers:

- Prof. Pieter De Wilde from University of Strathclyde in Scotland, the author of the term “performance gap” which is used to describe the substantial difference in energy and indoor climate performance between design and as-built
- Prof. Yiqun Pan is the lab leader for building simulation at Tongji University, China. She has a key role in the Chinese building simulation community and has authored two books in building performance simulation in Chinese language. She is also the conference chair of IBPSA world conference on Building Simulation in 2023 in Shanghai.

The conference committee highly appreciates and acknowledges the support from COWIfonden in attracting highly skilled and known researchers from the international community for two exciting keynote sessions.

The keynotes (one per day) will set the scene for the academic and professional audience and trigger exciting discussions on how building simulation plays a key role in the green transition of society.
